Materials

Yarn

- Aran weight yarn (worsted weight yarn can also be used): 300-400 yards
- Suggested yarn: Lion Brand Wool-Ease Thick & Quick or Red Heart Soft Essentials Chunky

Needles

- US size 8 (5mm) circular needles, 24-inch or 32-inch length
- US size 9 (5.5mm) circular needles, 24-inch or 32-inch length
- US size 8 (5mm) double-pointed needles (optional, for sleeves)

Other Materials

- Stitch markers
- Tapestry needle
- Buttons (optional, for closure)

Gauge

16 stitches and 20 rows in 4 inches of stocking stitch on US size 8 needles.

Sizes

The pattern includes instructions for the following sizes:

- 2-3 years (chest circumference: 22 inches)
- 4-5 years (chest circumference: 24 inches)
- 6-7 years (chest circumference: 26 inches)
- 8-9 years (chest circumference: 28 inches)
- 10-11 years (chest circumference: 30 inches)

Instructions

Cast On

• With US size 8 needles and yarn, cast on 70 (74, 80, 86, 92) stitches.

- Join in the round, being careful not to twist the stitches.

Ribbing

Work 2 (3, 3, 4, 4) rounds of 1x1 rib (knit 1, purl 1).

Body

- Switch to US size 9 needles.
- Work in stocking stitch (knit every row) for 6 (7, 8, 9, 10) inches from the ribbing.

Sleeves

- Divide the stitches evenly onto two circular needles (35 or 37 stitches per needle).
- Work in stocking stitch, increasing 1 stitch at the beginning of every 6th row until there are 45 or 47 stitches on each needle.
- Work in stocking stitch for 6 (7, 8, 9, 10) inches from the underarm.
- Bind off all stitches.

Assembly

- With a tapestry needle, sew the shoulder seams together.
- Set in the sleeves by sewing them to the body.
- Sew on buttons (optional) for closure.

Notes

The gauge is important for getting the correct size. If your gauge is different from the specified gauge, you may need to adjust the needle size or the

number of stitches cast on.

If you're new to knitting, there are many resources available online and in libraries to help you learn the basics.

Don't be afraid to make mistakes! Knitting is a learning process, and mistakes are a natural part of it. Just rip out the stitches and try again.

Take your time and enjoy the process. Knitting is a relaxing and rewarding hobby.

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
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
